TRULY, God loves you as you are and can't love you anymore than God already does! AND how we live matters—to changes our lives and the lives of those around us.

What faith practice might you learn by doing this Lent? In what ways are you hoping to grow? Perhaps you would like to:

- Pick up the free Lenten devotional from outside the church office and read it daily...
- Spend time in prayer—praying in motion or to music or in silence or through scripture or while creating or cleaning... or throughout each part of the day—talking with God and listening all day long...
- Cut back 15 minutes or 30 minutes or an hour or more of tech time/tv times each day; opening that time for other activities. Consider using this time connecting with God or others. You could read your Bible or devotional or call a friend or write a letter or go for a walk or create something or serve in some way...
- Handle your worries in a different way... Worry is a part of life AND you can choose to pray about things you are worried about and let them go (again and again if needed)... Pray, let go and work to change what you can vs sitting in the worry...
- Utilize 2 resources available outside the church office—You are beloved of God and so much more! This resource includes nearly 4 pages of scriptures and statements about who God makes us to be. Five statements for posting around the house or putting in your pocket to carry with you throughout the day are also available.
- As you shower or wash your hands remember your baptism. You are God's beloved child, washed in the waters of baptism and always being made new through Christ!






