

Council Meeting Highlights from Mtg. on April 15, 2024

- 1. Treasurer Wescott gave an update on the current CD for the Roof Fund (\$53,000.00) earning (3.83%) which comes due on 4/17/24. The CD will be rolled over for 15 months and an interest rate of 4.55% has been secured for the funds.
- Church Council

- 3. Council had a general discussion of additional projects that they will be looking into. Phone system, AED for the basement and first aid kits, replacement of older emergency EXIT signage and lighting, as well as, offering additional handicap parking stalls in our parking lots. Information will be gathered and presented for review and consideration.


