The 2024 Northern Illinois Synod Assembly was held via Zoom for the Budget Forum & Resolution Forum on Tuesday evening, June 11 and in person at Augustana College, Friday, June 14, and Saturday, June 15 under the theme, "Open God's Story". We focused on God's stories - both in scripture and in our lives - and how these stories change us. The Assembly was joined by The Rev. Miguel Gomez-Acosta, the Senior Director for New Ministry Development and Evangelism at the Churchwide Office of the ELCA.

Outside of doing the business of the Synod, like passing the budget and electing people to various committees, we had a Ministry Fair. This was a time - with dessert - that is focused on celebrating ministry in and around our synod.

Three resolutions were proposed, discussed and passed: R-1: Resolution for Celebrating and Supporting the 50th Anniversary of ELCA World Hunger and R-2: Resolution for the Northern Illinois Synod to Consider Becoming Reconciling in Christ and R-3: Resolution to Reject Christian Nationalism You can watch several of the Synod Assembly sessions and worship at
